



Dieter Mueller-Dombois

July 26, 1925 - July 19, 2022

Born July 26, 1925, Germany, the son of Johanna Dombois and the historian Georg Müller grew up in Bethel near Bielefeld. He studied at the University of Hohenheim, where he graduated in 1951 with a degree in agricultural engineering. He then moved to the University of British Columbia, where he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Forestry and received a Ph. D. in Forest Ecology in 1960.

From 1958 to 1963 he was employed as a Forest Research Officer in the Canada Department of Forestry, Winnipeg, Manitoba and then moved to the University of Hawaii, where he worked from 1963 to 1968 as Assistant Professor of Botany and then until 1972 as Associate Professor of Botany. From 1972 until his retirement in 1990, Mueller-Dombois was Professor of Botany at the University of Hawaii.

He is survived by his wife Annette, sons Stefan, Markus, and Tilman, daughter Christine Dombois-Strong and brother Lorenz Dombois.
