



Michael Oliver Kaomea Vasconcellos

June 29, 1945 - December 30, 2014

Mike Vasconcellos, 69 of Honolulu, former Athletic Director of Chaminade University, died on December 30, 2014 at a care home in Ewa Beach. He was born in Honolulu.

Mike said some of the things he would like to be remembered for in his sports career is quarterbacking St. Louis to a 28 to 7 win over Farrington in 1962, the upset win of Chaminade over Virginia on December 3, 1987 while he was Athletic Director, the Maui Classic, now the EA Sports Maui Invitational and his induction to the Silverswords Hall of Fame.

Mike was a coach, at Santa Clara, and St. Louis High School.

He is survived by his daughter, Ki'ilani Hanakeola Spencer; son, Kaipo James Kawika Kamai.
